

## Fly-in to RAF Cranwell on 2nd August.

All Rotarian flyers and guests are welcome to the annual club fly-in at RAF Cranwell in Lincolnshire and 2nd August. The plan for the day is as follows:

- Pre-registration (aircraft type, reg, POB) by email to Ken Baker ([kenbakerpriorycloseru@talktalk.net](mailto:kenbakerpriorycloseru@talktalk.net))
- Arrival and departure for visiting aircraft is strictly PPR. Pilots will be required to telephone Cranwell Operations Squadron (01400 26 7377/7378) during station working hours. When telephoning, please have insurance details at hand and be prepared to fax proof of Crown indemnity. (note Cranwell Operations Squadron is normally closed at weekends). It is possible that the phone contact number may change, however that will be confirmed in the arrival brief that will be sent to all nearer the time. But it would be advisable to PPR on the Friday prior to the FLY IN on the Sunday.
- Full details will be circulated to all registered participants in advance of the day

- £5 per plane temporary membership - please pay by cheque - we have no credit card or cash facilities
- Includes hospitality area for visiting aircrew to have food and drink, on arrival.
- Arrival 9am to 12 noon
- Anticipated flying displays by Spitfire, Harvard, Chipmunks, Pitts, Yak 3, P51
- Ground displays of some of these aircraft, including the Spitfire, Tutor, Jaguar
- Take part in aerobatics in Fireflies
- Trial lessons in Grob 115
- Displays of second world war vehicles and period re-enactors.
