The airport will charge the following fees for a P28A or C172:

Parking € 31.65 (24 hrs)

Please have your noise or similar certificate after landing with you at the GAT in order to pay the reduced landing fee only.

It is essential, that you fill out the registration sheet completely for each crewmember and pax in your aircraft or car since we have to deliver a list of the participants to Airbus GmbH 14 days in advance. You should have your identity card or passport with you.
