You don't have to be a pilot (only a Rotarian) to be a member of The International Fellowship of Flying Rotarians

IFFR is one of the oldest Rotary Fellowships and was formally established in 1965. The activities of IFFR bring together flying and non-flying Rotarians alike in local section meetings all over the world. Many members have flown their private aircraft overseas for Conventions, fly-in events, Rotary service projects, and various other home club and district programmes. International understanding has and will continue to benefit through this Fellowship.

The UK Section has over a hundred members and holds weekend meetings each year (in the last two years to Swansea, Norwich, Rochester and Kendal) and a mid week visit (such as RAF Uxbridge Battle of Britain Control bunker and the RAF Museum at Cosford). Members from other European Sections normally fly into these meetings, and during the last couple of years UK members have flown to meetings in France, Portugal, Germany, Italy, Denmark, Sweden and Finland.

- ◆ Regular contact with others who share your interests – Rotary and Aviation
- ◆ The opportunity to take part with other members in visits at home and abroad, to Air shows, Museums, Rallies, Reunions and other aviation events

Dear Fellow Rotarian

If you have just qualified for your Private Pilots Licence, where do you go next? The IFFR has one-day events which are ideal if you are hiring a Club aircraft, and many of these events have no up front commitment – so you can decide on the day if the weather is within your personal limits without losing a deposit.

You will not feel out of place if you drive to an event. For the average event, 25-50% of members arrive by road or scheduled air – much higher if the weather is bad!

Whilst membership is only open to current active or honorary Rotarians, once you have joined you may normally bring a friend, spouse or partner to events – ideal if you share an aircraft with a non-Rotarian.

Combining an interest in aviation with the fellowship of Rotary makes an ideal basis for enjoyable meetings.
